Salina Public Schools will host seven sites that will be open between 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. from March 23-27.

- Available to all children ages 1-18.
- No signup, eligibility, or paperwork required.
- Children must be present per federal government (USDA) requirements.
- Visit any site regardless of school attended.

Salina Public Schools' teachers are working with Kansas State Department of Education guidelines to create a new learning model for Salina students.
