## **KESA**

- Kansas Education Systems Accreditation (KESA) is the Kansas model for K-12 accreditation
- Ensures the Kansas education system is meeting the needs of each student it serves
- Based on a five-year cycle of continuous improvement
- SPS began YEAR 1 of the accreditation cycle in Fall 2022

# KESA CYCLE (2022 - 2027)

Our KESA Goals for the next five year accreditation cycle (2022-2027) will be based on our Strategic Plan goals to:

- Increase students' critical thinking skills
- Increase students' communication skills
- Increase students' social-emotional skills

### **During Year 1**

- Conduct district and building needs assessments
- Set new district and building measurable goals by February 2023

# **KESA YEAR 1 PROCESS**

### July - December 2022

- District and building needs assessments conducted

### January 2023

District and building overarching KESA goals finalized

### January – May 2023

Long-range continuous improvement plan developed

### **April 2023**

Outside Visitation Team (OVT) visit conducted

### **May 2023**

KESA Year 1 System Report and the OVT Summary Report submitted

## **Critical Thinking Growth Measures**

- Math
  - Students will have the critical thinking skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 10% increase in the number of students performing at a Level 3 or 4 (above grade level) on the Kansas Math Assessment by 2027.
  - Students will have the critical thinking skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 12% decrease in the number of students performing at a Level 1 (below grade level) on the Kansas Math Assessment by 2027.

## **Critical Thinking Growth Measures**

- Science
  - Students will have the critical thinking skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 10% increase in the number of students performing at a Level 3 or 4 (above grade level) on the Kansas Science Assessment by 2027.
  - Students will have the critical thinking skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by an 11% decrease in the number of students performing at a Level 1 (below grade level) on the Kansas Science Assessment by 2027.

### **Communication Growth Measures**

- Reading
  - Students will have the communication skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 10% increase in the number of students performing at a Level 3 or 4 (above grade level) on the Kansas Reading Assessment by 2027.
  - Students will have the communication skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 13% decrease in the number of students performing at a Level 1 (below grade level) on the Kansas Reading Assessment by 2027.

### **Social-Emotional Growth Measures**

- Students will have the social-emotional skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 15% decrease in the number of socialemotional behavior offenses by 2027.
- Students will have the social-emotional skills to achieve postsecondary success as measured by a 15% decrease in the number of students who are chronically absent by 2027.
